

He was born in Riverside Cemetery in 2011 and was first spotted by the crew where they found him sleeping next to this headstone with the name “George” on it.

George’s family has frequented Riverside over the years and includes Mamma, Gerald, Grandpa, Skippy and others. Visitors and families who have loved ones buried here find a level of spiritual comfort and peace when they spot George or other deer passing by or basking in the sun in the middle of a section.

Not only does Riverside Cemetery provide a sacred, eternal resting place

in the Historical Landmark Neighborhood of the Brooklyn Centre Community of Greater Cleveland, it is a Certified Wildlife Habitat providing green space in the city for walking, reflecting, meditating and enjoying the beauty that each season brings.

Located in the midst of one of the most urbanized watersheds in Cleveland, Riverside Cemetery provides the four basic elements of a Certified Wildlife Habitat: food, water, cover, and places for wildlife to raise young.

Rocks, ground cover, and low lying shrubs act as cover from predators and provide natural homes for many creatures that otherwise would be unable to survive in our urban area.

Trees throughout the grounds provide homes and shelter for many different kinds of wildlife. Birds use the stand of trees along the Cemetery’s southern boundary as a resting place as they migrate north in the spring and south in the fall. Owls, warblers, flickers, and many more species are sighted in and around the Cemetery throughout the year.

After one of the toughest winters we have had in several years, we are looking forward to spring and the life and beauty it brings to these historic and sacred grounds.




EVERGREEN HILL CEMETERY

CHAGRIN FALLS, OHIO



Evergreen Hill Cemetery was established in 1863 by the Chagrin Falls Township Trustees to meet the growing needs of Chagrin Falls Village and Chagrin Township. Walking through the older section of the cemetery one will find numerous stones that predate 1863. These are individuals whose loved ones moved them from family land plots, or from the older town cemetery located on Grove Hill.

Sections One through Thirteen were laid out first, followed by sections Fourteen through Eighteen with two plots for the “poor”. The cemetery currently consists of 48 acres with 20 being used for cemetery plots divided into 53 sections. There are over 5000 people buried at Evergreen Hill.

The mausoleum was built in 1876. Prior to that time, the cemetery contracted with Solon to house deceased individuals during the Winter months when the ground was to frozen to dig graves.

A dominant feature of Evergreen Hill Cemetery, and the focus of present day Memorial Day programs, is the Civil War Memorial. During the War, Chagrin, like many other communities, had a very active Soldiers Aid Society. The women of the Village met on a regular basis to make bandages, clothing, raise funds and to gather materials that were sent to soldiers serving throughout the country. At the end of the war, they had \$134 left in their treasury. Led by Jane E Church, they raised additional funds to create the monument which was dedicated September 10, 1867. The monument honors 21 “Chagrin Boys” who died in places like Gettysburg, Big Creek, Arkansas and



Andersonville prison. In all, over 100 veterans of the Civil War are buried in Evergreen Hill.

For a period of time, because of the beauty of the cemetery, it became a prestigious place to be buried. Many plots were being purchased by people outside of Chagrin Falls. The cemetery now is restricted to residents of Chagrin Falls Village and Township. An average of 45 burials are conducted each year with 30 of those being cremations. Four years ago an all granite Columbarium was installed that has 48 niches, along with two granite cremation benches. Non-residents are able to purchase a Columbarium niche or bench.

In 1965, a fire in Village Hall destroyed a large portion of the cemetery records. Many of the records have been reconstructed and have been digitized. In 2013 the Cemetery Board purchased a system to put the cemetery records on the web. The Sexton, Rob Arnold, is part of the Service Department. He has held this position for 15 years.





CREMATORY OPERATOR CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

and

ADVANCED CREMATORY OPERATOR CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

The Ohio Cemetery Association in conjunction with Matthews Cremation Division will be hosting their second Crematory Operator Certification Program at the OCA Annual Convention. This program was so well received last year that we are pleased to be offering it again. This course is a 7 hour educational program designed to raise the level of knowledge and understanding of the design, operation, and maintenance of cremation equipment as well as day to day operations. Matthews Cremation Division, the leaders in Crematory Operator Certification are qualified and approved to train in all 50 states including states currently requiring certification. MCD certification is valid for 5 years from the program date.

In addition to the Crematory Operator Certification Program, this year we are pleased to announce that an additional class, *Advanced* Crematory Operations will also be offered. This course is for the experienced operator looking to further their knowledge. Topics include Ethics & Professionalism in the Crematory, Advanced Operating Techniques, Cremation Liabilities and a series of professionally prepared series of operational videos that demonstrate each step of the cremation process. The *Advanced* course is not a certification course.

The Ohio Cemetery Association is working to establish approval for continuing education credits for funeral directors who take these courses that are licensed in the states of Ohio, Indiana, and Kentucky. The Crematory Operator Certification will be held on August 7, 2014 at the Marriott Cincinnati-North at Union Centre. Registration for this course is \$395.00. The *Advanced* Crematory Operations course will be held at the same location on August 8, 2014. Registration for this course is \$195.00. Participants who register for both courses enjoy a reduced registration rate of \$495.00 for both sessions. Room rates for guests staying at the Marriott will be available at a later date.
