With over 200 acres, 3000 trees, and more than 1000 flowers planted each year, a historic cemetery/arboretum is a great place to bee a bee!





Southern Section Spotlight:

Located next to the University of Dayton and to the south of Stewart Street, the first burial in the Southern District took place in 1969.

Offering more availability of spaces in closer proximity to one another, the Southern District offers a variety of landscaped vignettes.

If you're walking at Woodland, it's well worth a visit!





The Sanctuary:

Located in section 309, the Sanctuary features a terracotta pathway which leads to a round flower garden; benches located on either side invite you to rest while you visit. Surrounding the front area are Red Branched Dogwood bushes, which will provide color all year round.

Pine Cathedral:

In the sunny Southern District, Pine Cathedral is an inviting shady spot. Surrounded by towering trees, these burial spaces offer a sense of shelter and solitude. A cylindrical columbarium rests in the middle of this section, containing of 78 single or companion niches for cremation interments. Its columns, which are carved to resemble tree bark, give this columbarium a natural look and feel.

The third annual Before I Die Ohio Festival (Oct. 25 & 26) will offer upbeat activities to think about, talk about, and do something about our inevitable mortality.




If you need help finding where someone is buried, need directions to a particular area, or have questions about pre-planning or funeral services, Woodland's Staff is here to assist you!
